This meeting brings together the Asian and the European Workshops on Econometrics and Health Economics for their first joint event. These long-running series of workshops provide a forum for the development and dissemination of applications of econometrics in health economics. The joint event aims to: promote health economics research with an applied focus; strengthen research networks between Asia and Europe; and build the research capacity of early-career researchers in both Asia and Europe.

The Workshop

The workshop program consists of up to 16 oral and 10 poster presentations. For oral presentations, each paper is allocated 50 minutes, made up of a presentation by the author, followed by comments from a discussant and a general discussion. In the organized poster session, the author presents four 15-minute talks in front of a small group of audience. The number of participants will be limited to 55. Workshop participants will be expected to attend the whole of the meeting and play a role as either author, discussant, or chairperson.

The workshop will begin with a preworkshop dinner on Wednesday, August 27. The workshop concludes at noon on Saturday, August 30, followed by an optional half-day tour to visit an old part of the city.
