Econometrics and Health Economics

This series of workshops provides a forum for the development and dissemination of applications of econometrics in health economics.

The workshop will follow the format of the long-running European Workshops on Econometrics and Health Economics, with a particular vision to: Promote health economics research with applied microeconomics focus in Asia; strengthen research network within the region; develop research network with other regions; and build on the research capacity of early-career health economists in Asia.

The Workshop

The workshop program consists of up to 13 oral and 10 poster presentations. For oral presentations, each paper is allocated one hour, made up of a presentation by the author, followed by a response from a discussant and a general discussion. In the poster session, the author presents four 15-minute talks in front of a small group of audience. The number of participants will be limited to 48. **Workshop participants will be expected to attend the whole of the meeting** and play a role as either author, discussant, or chairperson.

The workshop will begin with a pre-workshop dinner on Wednesday, Dec 13. In the Thursday morning, we will have keynote lectures by:

The workshop concludes at noon on Saturday, Dec 16, followed by an optional half-day study tour to visit a deprived community near Manila.
